Andrew Melville is a composer and assistant conductor of the London Recorder Orchestra in which he plays contrabass. He has composed many pieces for recorder orchestra, including Brightness Falls, Lachrimae Tango and a Concerto Grosso with three soloists (Tr, Ten, B). He runs a recorder evening class in Wandsworth, London and has conducted at the Northern Recorder Course and Cheltenham Recorder Festival. He is interested in a wide range of music from Machaut to minimalism, Tallis to tango.

There will be four sessions of playing conducted by Andrew, with breaks in between, including a break for lunch from 1.00p.m. to 2.00p.m. Refreshments at breaks are included, but please bring a packed lunch.
