Since 2013 she has co-organised ORDA: Open Recorder Days Amsterdam, a biennial festival which is one of the biggest pro-am recorder events in the world. As a performer, she has performed in concert halls from Europe to Australia, has recorded several CDs with her own groups (Ensemble Odyssee and The Royal Wind Music) and has established her own digital recital series.
